



# <u>Do my property taxes fund all of these</u> governments?

Local Governments receive taxes ONLY from properties within their service area.

This means that a property in Carbondale does not pay taxes to the Grand River Hospital District, and a property in Glenwood does not pay taxes to School District 16 in Parachute.

However, all property owners pay taxes to Garfield County, the Colorado River Water Conservation District, the Garfield County Library District, one school district, and one fire district. Most properties in Garfield County pay taxes to Colorado Mountain College as well.

Each of these governments is directed by people that live within the service area, and they are elected by the propety owners in that area. This is a great aspect of LOCAL government - that we live with those that serve us!
