Subject: Skier dies at Sunlight Mountain Ski Resort

Identity of Deceased: Job Henning, 48-year-old male, resident of Bethesda, MD.

On February 23, 2021, the Garfield County Coroner's Office was notified of a death at Sunlight Mountain Resort near Glenwood Springs, CO. Coroner's Office investigators responded and learned that a 48-year-old male was found unresponsive at the base of a tree. Good Samaritans found Mr. Henning and initiated CPR until Sunlight Ski Patrol arrived and transported the male to the first aid area where they met a Glenwood Springs Fire Department ambulance. Mr. Henning could not be resuscitated and was declared deceased.

The male was later identified as Job Henning, 48-years old, and a resident of Bethesda, MD. Mr. Henning was on vacation with his wife and two children. At the time of the incident, Mr. Henning was reported to have been skiing with his teenage daughter who was further downhill and did not witness the incident.

On February 24, 2021 an autopsy was performed on Mr. Henning by the Coroner's Office contract forensic pathologist. The cause of death is blunt force injuries of the head and the manner of death will be classified as an accident.

The Coroner's Office extends their deepest condolences to the friends and family of Mr. Henning.
