Subject: Decedent Identification, cause, and manner of death on bicyclist vs. motor vehicle crash on June 3, 2018 in Glenwood Springs, CO.

Identity of Deceased: Scott William Adams, 54-year-old male, resident of Glenwood Springs, CO.

On Sunday June 3, 2018, at around 3:12am the Garfield County Coroner's Office was dispatched to Valley View Hospital for a report of a death. Coroner's Office investigators learned the decedent was riding a bicycle near the intersection of 27th Street and Glen Avenue in Glenwood Springs when he was involved in a crash involving his bicycle and a motor vehicle travelling Northbound on Glen Ave. The decedent was transported to Valley View Hospital and pronounced dead at 3:12am by emergency department physicians.

The coroner's office contract forensic pathologist performed an autopsy on Mr. Adams. The autopsy revealed multiple blunt force injuries. The cause of death is multiple blunt force injuries and the manner of death is accident. Toxicological examination performed on the blood of Mr. Adams showed the presence of marijuana metabolites (THC, 22.3 ng/ml; THC-COOH, 110 ng/ml). No other drugs were detected.
