Subject: February 14, 2019 pedestrian fatality on Interstate 70 near mile marker 116.5 Glenwood Springs, CO.

Identity of Deceased: Connie Leckwold, 64-years old, resident of Glenwood Springs, CO.

On Thursday February 14, 2019 at 7:03pm, the Garfield County Coroner's Office was dispatched to Interstate 70 in Glenwood Springs for a report of a pedestrian fatality on the interstate. Coroner's Office investigators arrived to the scene and met with Glenwood Springs Police.

Investigators learned the decedent was female and had sustained extensive trauma to her body. The decedent was not carrying any identification. Coroner's Office investigators submitted fingerprints to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI) Forensic Services Unit in Grand Junction, CO to assist in identifying the decedent.

The decedent has been identified as Connie Leckwold, 64 years old, a resident of Glenwood Springs, CO.

On Sunday February 17, 2019, the Garfield County Coroner's Office contract pathologist performed an autopsy. The cause of death is multiple blunt force injuries. The manner of death is under investigation while coroner's office and law enforcement investigators gather more details of the death investigation.
