

Purge Your Spurge

Get rid of this highly invasive noxious weed and get FREE landscape plants!

How: Pull and bag your spurge. Contact a sponsor, see list below. They'll come to you and verify it's spurge (Myrtle or Cypress), and give you a voucher that you may exchange for landscape or garden plants at the Mountain Valley Greenhouse in Glenwood Springs.

Pulling Tips: Try to remove at least 4 inches of the root. Collect the plants in plastic bags. Dispose of bagged spurge in your trash. **DO NOT COMPOST!**
