

Do Not Spray Request

Noxious weed management on roadside rights-of-way in Garfield County is the responsibility of Garfield County Vegetation Management and is mandated by the Colorado Noxious Weed Act. Property owners requesting that no herbicides be sprayed on rights-of-way which front their property are responsible for noxious weed management within that area. Failure to control the weeds will result in the resumption of spraying operations.

Upon our receipt of this form you will be issued 2 signs which must be posted in the following manner: (Only the supplied signs will be recognized for no-spray zones)

- One sign at each end of your property. Spraying will end at the first sign and resume after the second sign.
- Signs must be visible to oncoming traffic, at least 36 inches above the ground and unobstructed.
- Requests must be submitted annually.
